Epworth Primary PTFA: General overview

Insurance: We pay £162.00 per year to be a member of Parent Kind: www.parentkind.org.uk

For that we get annual insurance which provides public liability up to £10,000 and personal injury cover up to £5000. This is with Zurich and known as a 'Charity and Social Organizations Insurance'.

The premium is taken automatically and managed by Karen (Treasurer).

The Parent Kind website is an extremely useful tool.

Dates: In January we sit down with Mr W and run through the events calendar for the year ahead. We confirm dates for:

- Easter raffle dates
- Ice Cream Van
- Sports Day
- Halloween Discos
- Pantomime (typically a weekend but be mindful of that weeks school activities)
- Christmas Fair

(any bake sales etc.. are planned ad-hoc, and just need checking with Mrs Johnson)

The PTFA pay for a balloon arch for the Year 6 leavers but any leaving celebration after that is organised directly with parents.

AGM: An AGM must be held within 15 months of the last. We tend to hold these end of Jan early Feb. Within the AGM Trustee positions must be re-voted, this meeting needs to be minutes with the minutes being circulated among parents and school staff.

Easter: PTFA use own funds to supply a chocolate bunny for each child (be mindful of those with allergies). This are typically purchased from Aldi and left with the school to distribute.

We also organise a raffle. The tickets are printed (organised by Karen the Treasurer at a cost of around £70) and sent home in children's bags. Raffle prizes are mainly made up of donated easter eggs bundled up.

The Ice-Cream van is invited to come in to school once a year during the summer term. The cost (so far) has been £1.50 per child. Nico's offered a choice of lollies or ice-cream (do make parents aware blue lollies will be offered).

Halloween Discos: We hire a DJ and provide the children with sweets, crisps and juice. Each discos lasts around 45 minutes and has been typically broken down in to

Nursery / Reception (2pm – 2.45pm)

Year 1 / 2 (2.45pm – 3.30pm)

Year 3 / 4 (3.30pm – 4.15pm)

Year 5 / 6 (4.30pm – 5.15) Note the slight gap between Year 3-4 and 5-6 as the older ones need to go home and have time to come back to school.

The discos need to be chaperoned by at least 2 parents at all times.

Tickets for the disco are sold for £2.50 each through Arbor and organised by Mrs Johnson and Karen (Treasurer).

Pantomime: The Baths Hall annually host a pantomime with the children and parents are invited to buy tickets for. Tickets are sold via Arbor (organised through Mrs Johnson and Karen Treasurer). We bulk purchase tickets as a 'class trip' and receive 3 free tickets for Chair, Secretary and Treasurer.

Christmas Fair: We invite Santa to come along and see the children and sit on a decorated grotto (the band stand) and receive a small, wrapped gift (donated by PTFA). Along with this we host a number of stands. Any external stall holders are charged £15.00, and children of the school can have a stand FOC. The PTFA typically hold a 'Bottle in the Bag'.
